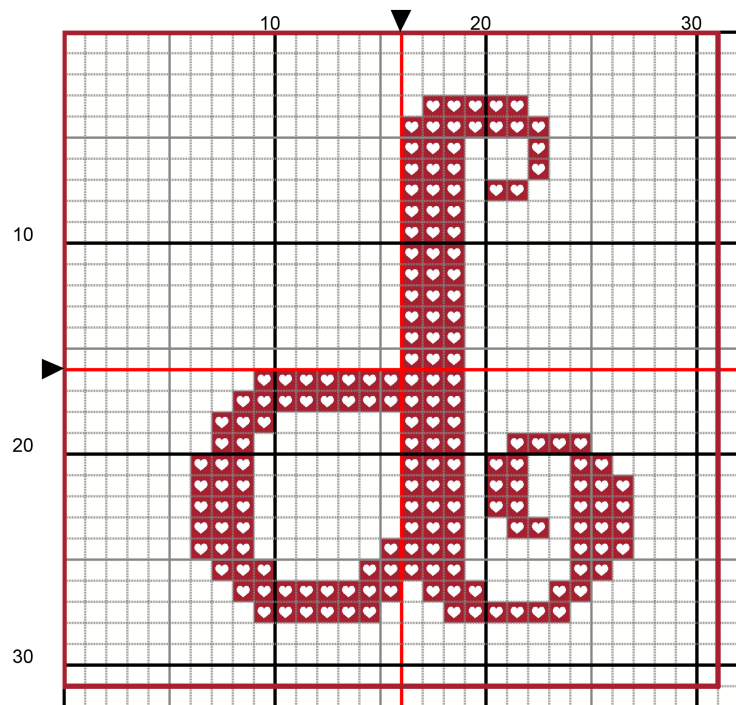
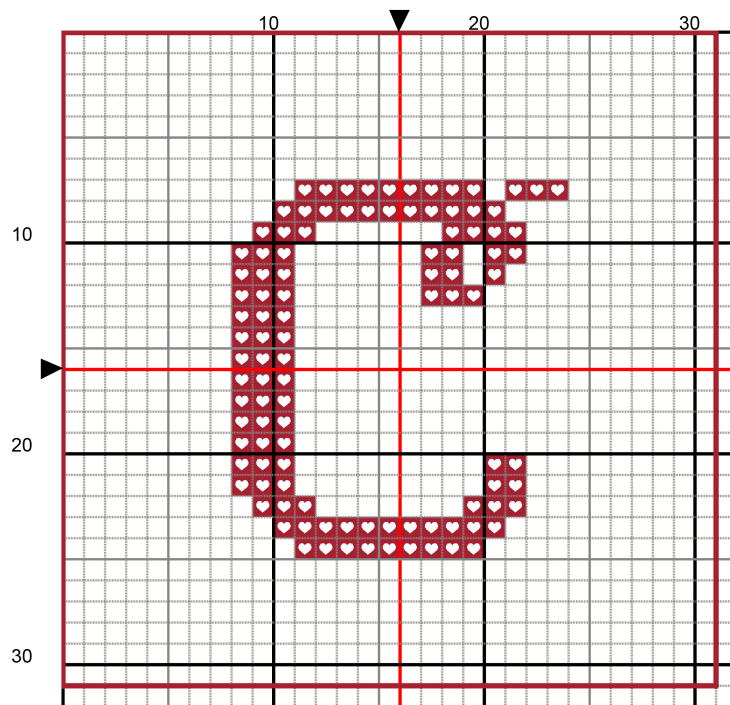
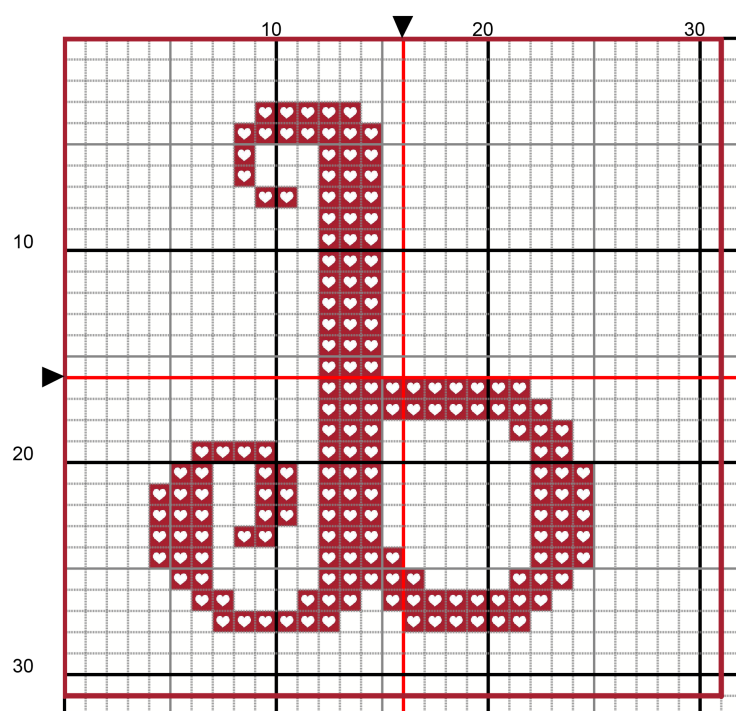
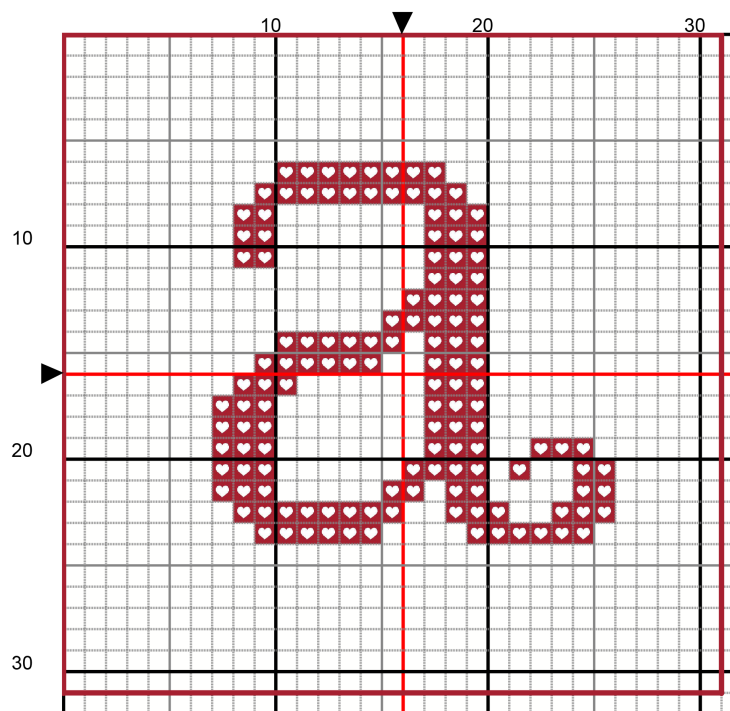
Alphabet for Jingle Ball Class Attendees

Thank you for purchasing my Jingle Ball class! We are sure to have a fun and festive time together.

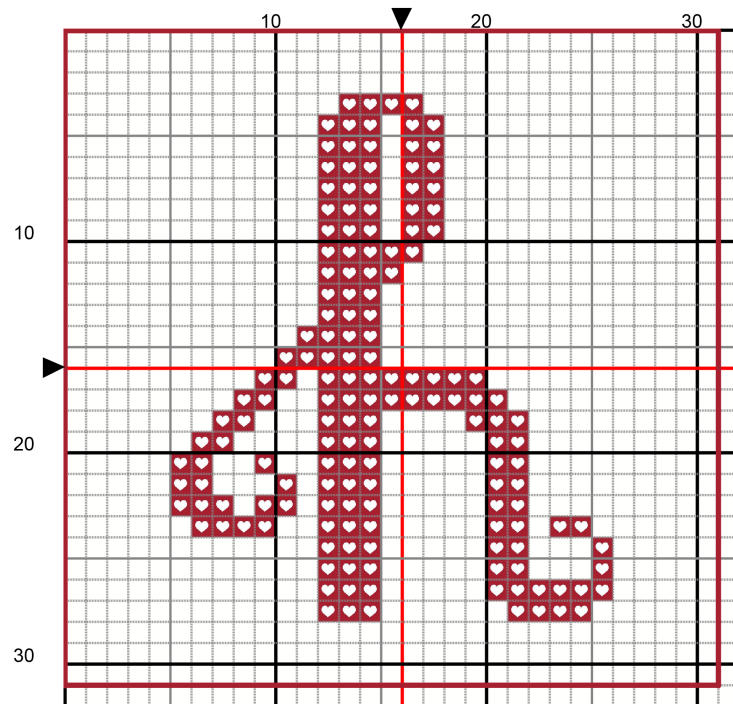
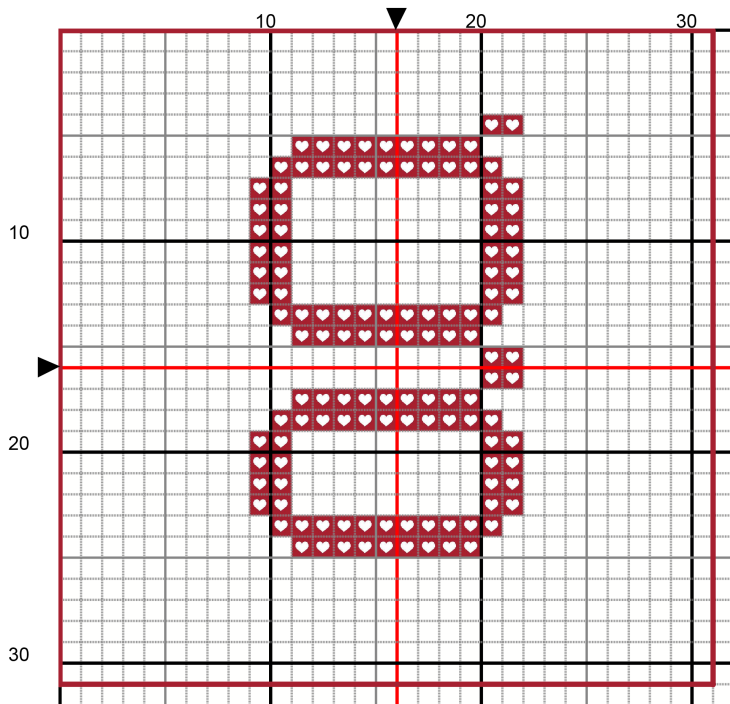
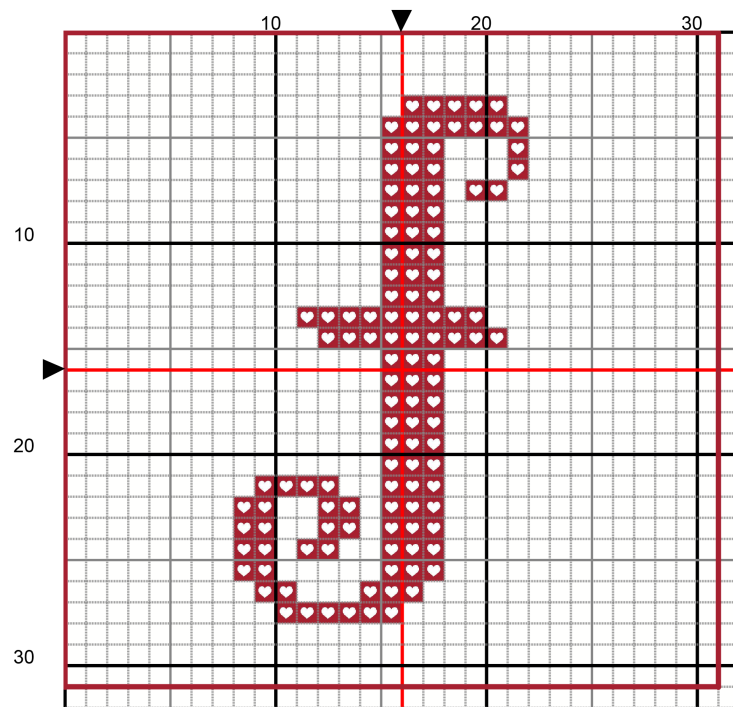
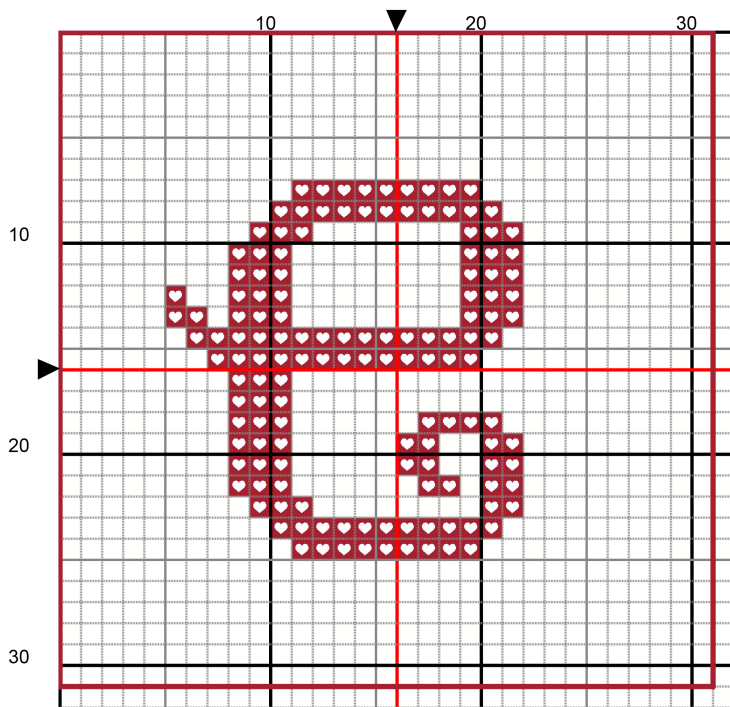

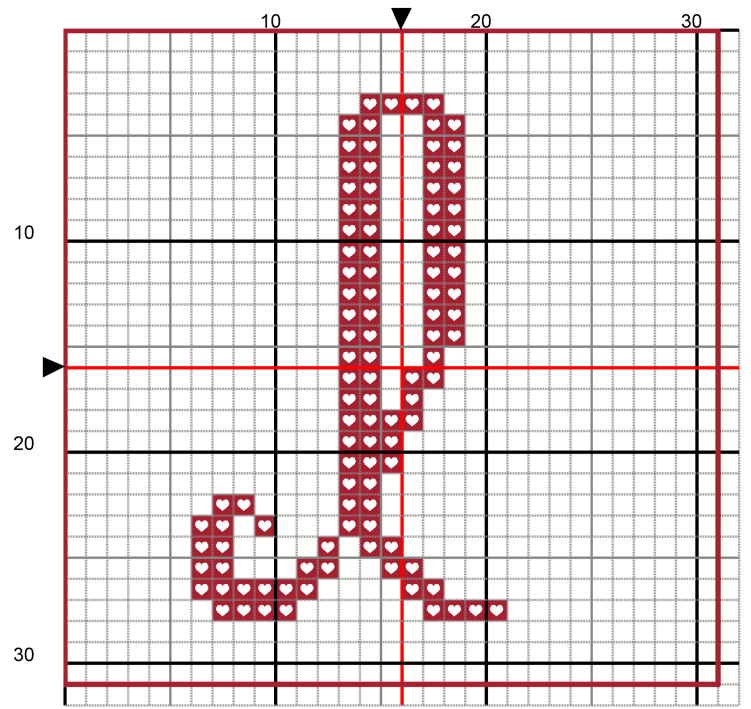
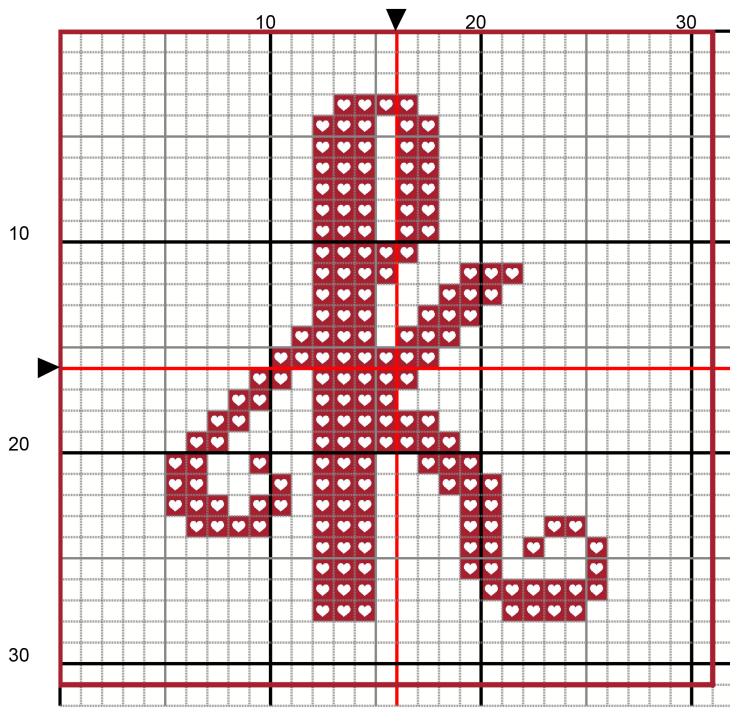
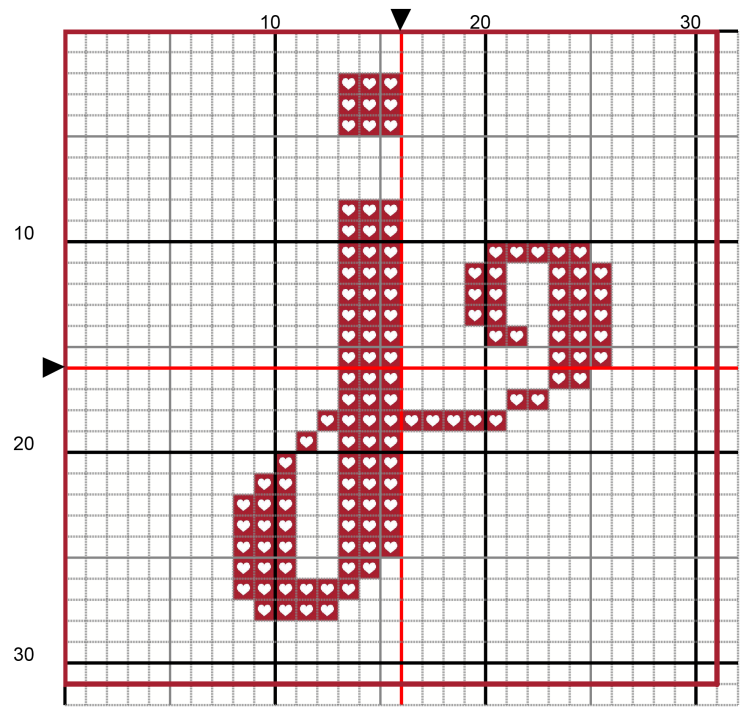
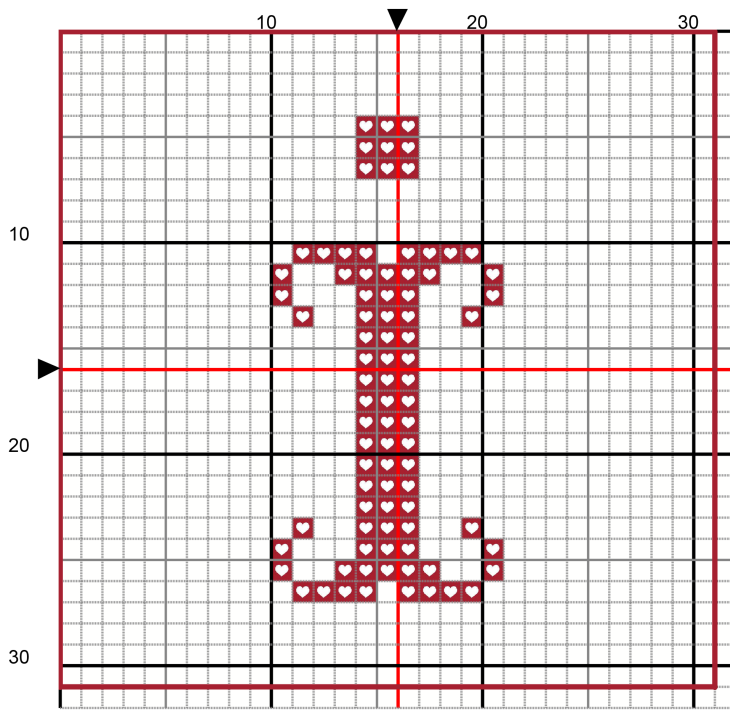
Please do not share this font with anyone. This is for you only. A year from the 2023 Jingle Ball I may release this alphabet along with the joy ornament.

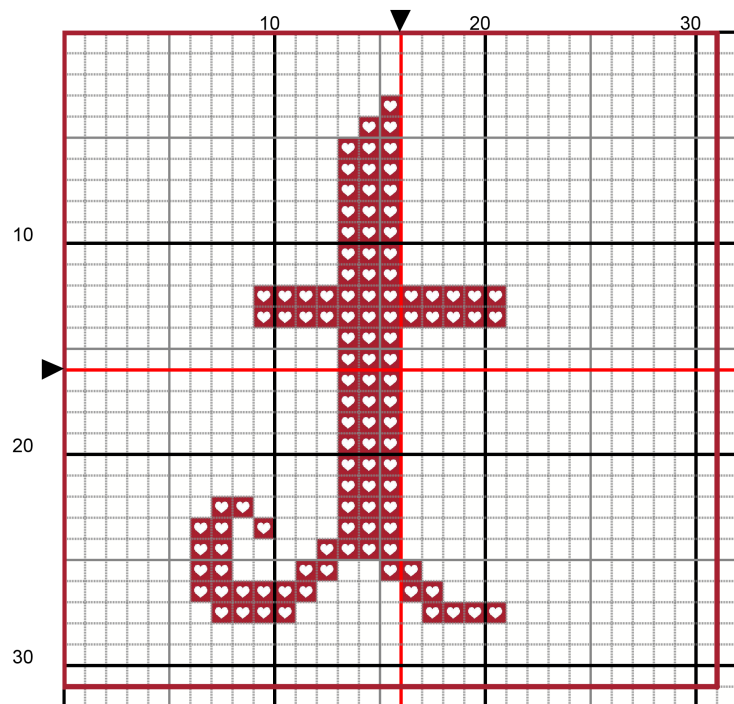
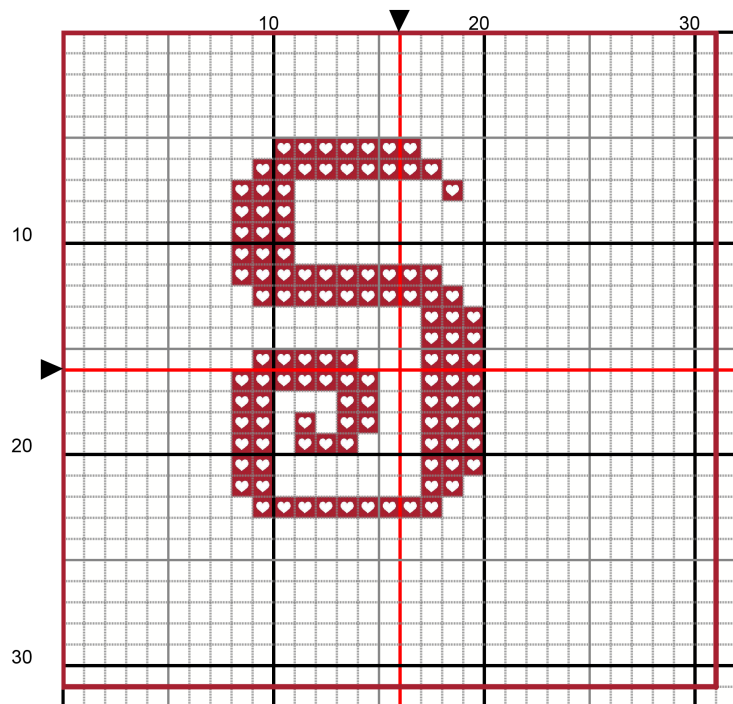
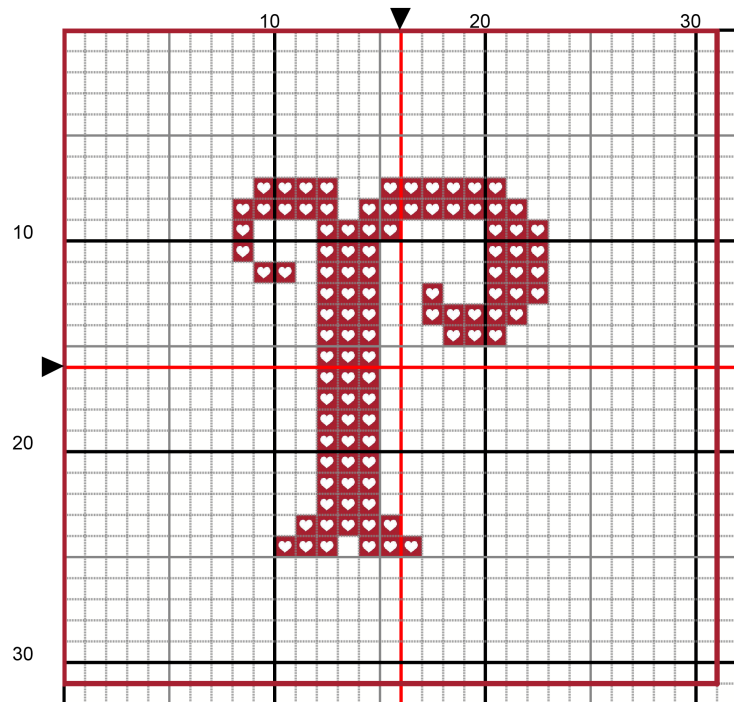
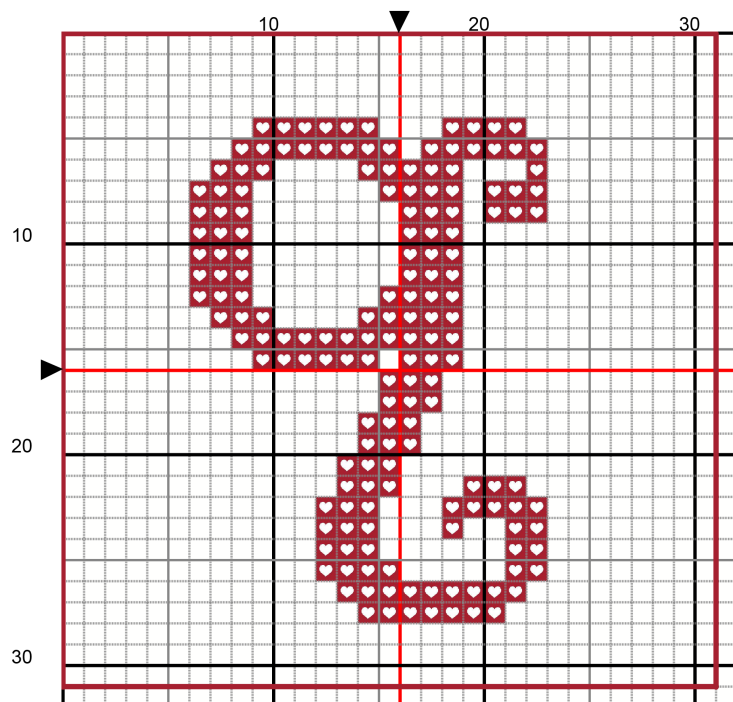

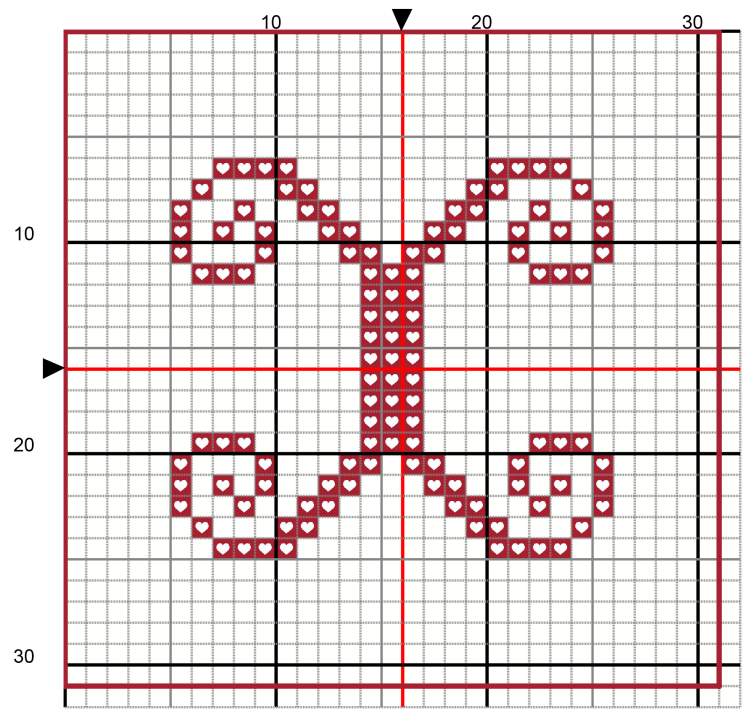
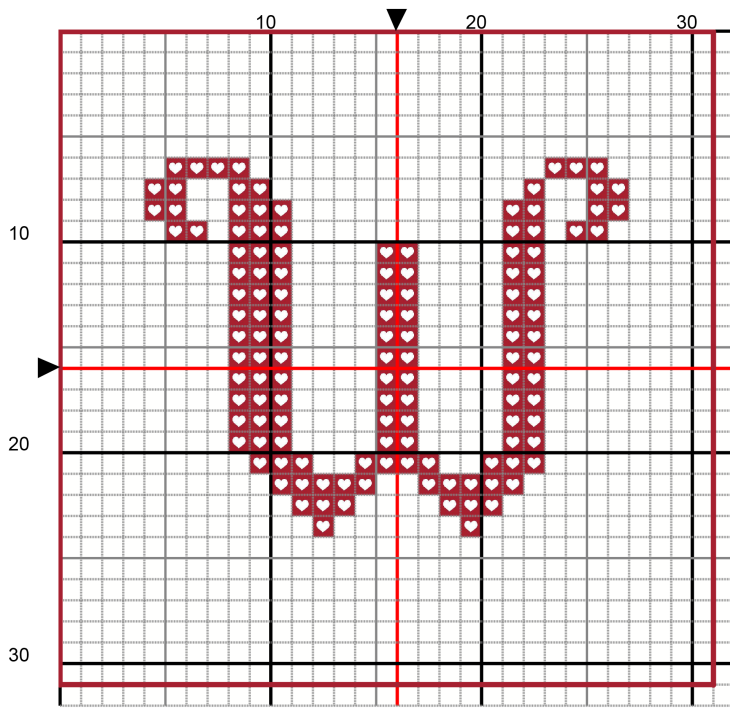
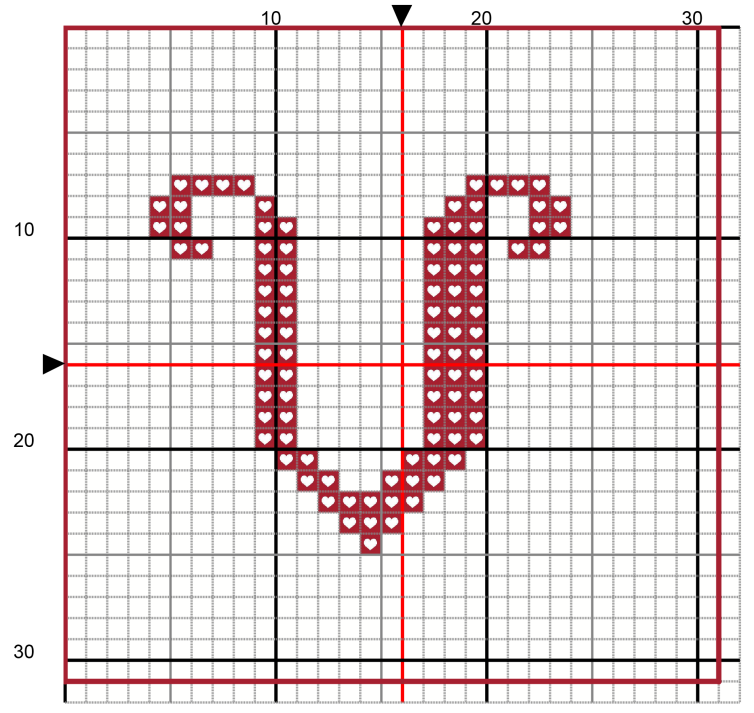
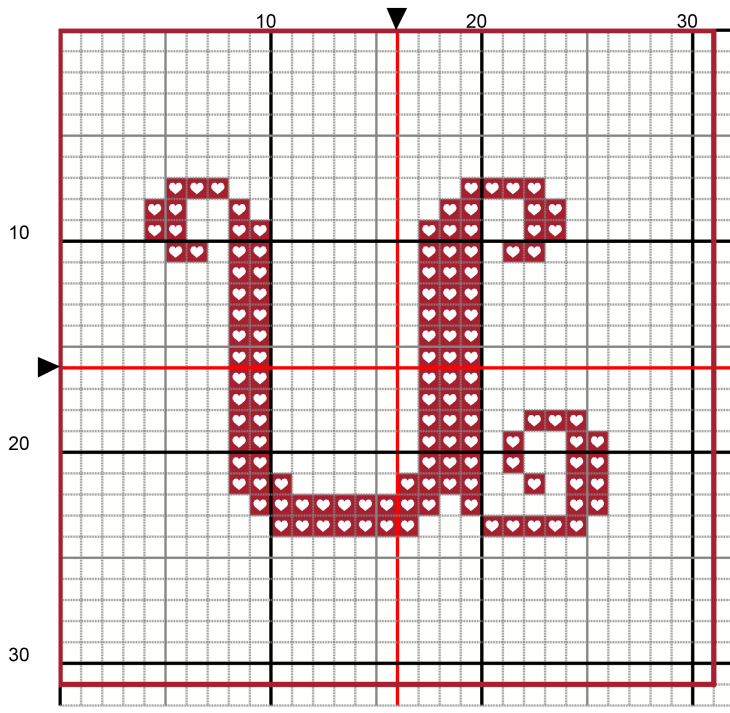


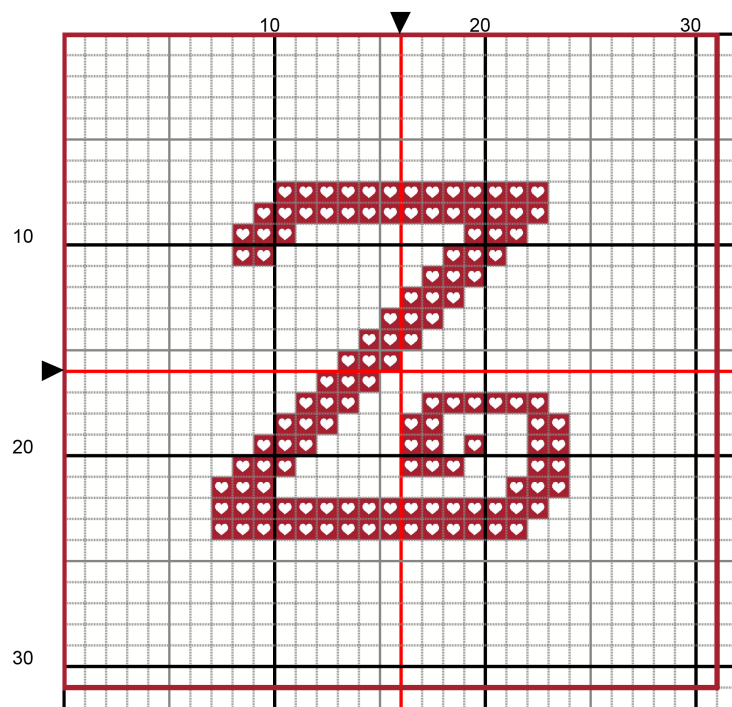
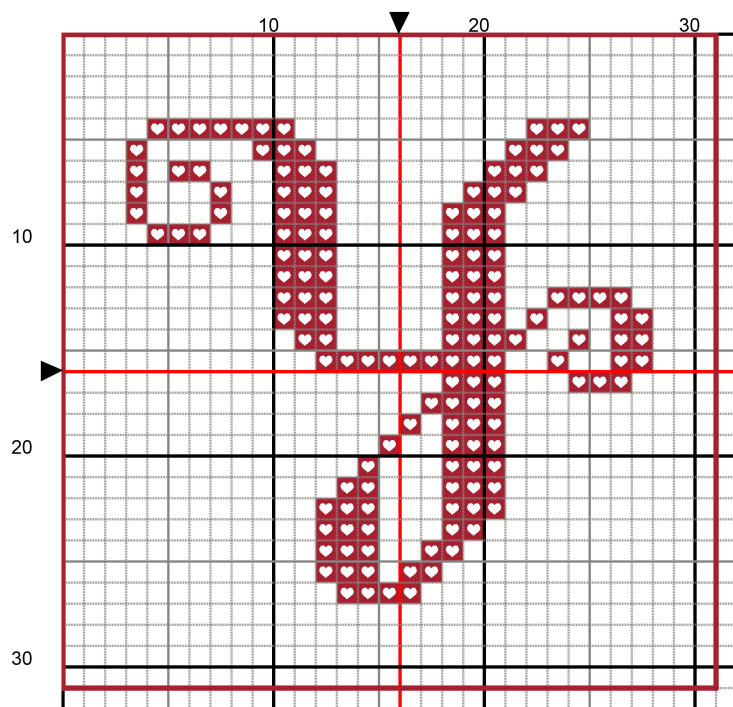
Here's a clever idea: stitch U.S.A. for the back of your J.O.Y. ornament so after Christmas you can still use it by flipping it over :)











Also coming soon.....just not sure how soon.....I plan to design other motifs like the Santa head so you can embellish the words you stitch. For instance, a snowman head so you can stitch the word S.N.O.W. and the “O” can be the snowman head.

Other examples are to design a heart which can replace the “O” in L.O.V.E.

The motifs can also be put at the beginning and/or the end of a word, for example, a four-leaf clover could be at the end of the word L.U.C.K.Y.

You get the idea. So again, look for that to come when I can find the time to design the motifs.
