CoCo's Garden Finishing Instructions by Susan Coates

Items Needed:


- Stitched piece
- Printed and cut Template
- Fabric for back of basket
- Fabric for lining of basket
- Frixion heat erase pen
- Pellon SP101
- Fusible fleece 971F
- Sewing machine
- Needle and thread
- 4 buttons
- Coated professional floral wire approximately 12 inches long
- Ribbon color of your choice
- 1. Center template over your completed stitching (note: the template is sized for the called for fabric count).
- 2. Trace template outline over the stitching using a heat erasable pen (Frixion is my preferred) and be sure that it is centered before cutting out your stitching.

Note: Susan had already finished CoCo's Garden before writing the instructions. Therefore, she is just using quilting fabric in these photos, not the stitched piece.

You will have your stitched piece, a backing fabric and two pieces for the inside of the basket.




3. Cut out 2 layers of Pellon SF101 from the template pattern. Be sure that the grain is straight and that you have the right sides together.








- 4. Fuse 1 piece to the back of the stitched piece and the other piece to the back of the chosen outer fabric according to the instructions. See above photos.
- 5. Cut out 2 layers of fusible fleece from the template pattern only to the dotted line on the pattern. Be sure that you have the right sides together.
- 6. Fuse 1 piece to the back of the stitched piece and the other piece to the back of the chosen outer fabric according to the instructions. See below photo.








- 7. Following the lines indicating the lining pieces, cut 2 from the chosen lining fabric with wrong sides together. See above photo left.
- 8. Cut out 2 layers of Pellon SF101 from the lining template pattern. Be sure that the grain is straight and that you have the right sides together. See above photo right.
- 9. Fuse to the back of each piece of the chosen lining fabric according to the instructions.






- 10.Cut out 2 layers of fusible fleece from the lining template only to the seam line on the pattern. Be sure that you have the right sides together.
- 11. Fuse to the back of each piece of the lining fabric according to the instructions. See above photos.





- 12. Align the top of one of the lining pieces with the top of the stitched piece with the right sides together using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance.
- 13. Repeat with the backing piece and the other lining piece.



- 14.Press seams toward the lining, turn right side up and stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from edge on the lining side on both pieces.
- 15. Place the 2 pieces right side together being sure that the lining pieces are right sides together and the stitched piece and the backing piece are right side together.





- 16.Pin or clip around the outer edges. Mark to leave a 2.5" opening at the bottom of the lining piece for turning.
- 17. Using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance stitch around the pieces, Be sure that the top seams are aligned properly.
- 18.Backstitch at either side of the opening in the lining.
- 19. Trim seams to $\frac{1}{4}$ " and clip across the corners to ease bulk. Do NOT cut the stitching.





- 20. Carefully turn the "basket" through the opening being sure to push the corners out using a chopstick.
- 21. Push the lining to the inside of the basket.
- 22. Whip stitch, by hand, the opening in the lining closed.



23. Sew buttons on each side leaving enough room for the wrapped wire to sit snuggly.

24.Cut a piece of wire approximately 12" long and bend into a handle shape. Form a U on each end to fit under the side buttons.





25. Wrap the wire with ribbon to cover.26. Make a bow for each side and attach.27. Your basket is ready to fill and hang.
